August 22	Announcement of vacancy via email to all members and posted on UF NOCCCD website (ufnorthorange.com).
August 28	Declarations of candidacy must be sent to Elections Committee Chair.
August 29	Acknowledgement of declarations of candidacy, distribute elections guidelines/rules for campaigning sent to candidates electronically from Elections Committee Chair.
August 31	Deadline for candidates to submit a statement to Elections Committee Chair. Statement is limited to 30 words.
September 1	Candidate statements will be sent via email to all members and posted on UF NOCCCD website (ufnorthorange.com). Deadline to request a paper ballot. Paper ballots can be sent to any Member who does not wish to vote electronically. A written request must be sent to the Elections Committee Chair. Paper ballots will be mailed to the last known address on file with CTA.
September 2	Paper ballots will be mailed to those members who requested. Deadline to inform Elections Committee Chair if candidate or designee will be observing counting of paper ballots, if any.
September 6	Voter credentials sent via email mail from third party vendor, Simply Voting. Please check your spam/junk folders if you do not receive an email. If you do not find the email, please contact the Elections Chair at jwalkeruf@gmail.com.
September 6-12	Voting via electronic platform beginning at 8am on September 6 and concluding at 3pm on September 12. Paper ballots must be received at the UF PO Box by 3pm on September 12 (postmarked date not accepted).
September 12	The Elections Committee will download results from Simply Voting, count any paper ballots received and prepare a Teller's Report. Results to leadership and candidates. Results will be emailed to members and posted on the UF NOCCCD website (ufnorthorange.com) by September 13. If a run-off election is necessary, this will be included in the announcement.
September 14	Deadline to request a paper ballot for run off, if necessary. Paper ballots will be mailed to the last known address on file with CTA.
September 22	Any challenge to the election must be received by the Elections Chair (jwalkeruf@gmail.com) no later than 6pm unless there is a run-off election.
September 16	Paper ballots for run-off, if necessary, will be mailed to members who requested. Deadline to inform Elections Committee Chair if candidate or designee will be observing counting of paper ballots, if any.

September 19	Voter credentials for run off, if necessary, sent via email from third party vendor, Simply Voting. Please check your spam/junk folders if you do not receive an email. If you do not find the email, please contact the Elections Chair at <u>jwalkeruf@gmail.com</u> .
September 19-26	Voting for run-off election, if necessary, via Simply Voting beginning at 8am September 19 and concluding at 3pm September 26. Paper ballots must be received at the UF PO Box by 3pm September 26 (postmarked date not accepted).
September 26	The Elections Committee will download results from Simply Voting, count any paper ballots received and prepare a Teller's Report. Results to leadership and candidates. Results will be emailed to members and posted on the UF NOCCCD website (ufnorthorange.com) by September 27.
October 6	If a run-off election was necessary, a challenge to the election, including the run- off election, must be received electronically by the Elections Chair (jwalkeruf@gmail.com) no later than 6pm.
