United Faculty leadership will be meeting on Monday with District HR to discuss the issues of workload, tenure review, performance evaluations, short term classes, lab classes, performance classes, clinicals, office hours, campus hours, and any other contractual issues that are impacted by the emergency response to COVID-19 (coronavirus).

We want to ensure that health and safety considerations are first and foremost, while protecting faculty contractual rights. The District and the state have an obligation to protect both. In addition, the state will be providing resources to mitigate the financial impact.

United Faculty initiated a meeting to be held on Tuesday with the three unions (United Faculty, CSEA, and AdFac), the three college presidents, and campus constituents to consolidate our planning efforts and present a unified message concerning the plan of action for faculty and the impact on working conditions.
