- A. Highlights from the BoT meeting the previous evening, including many classified employees speaking on negotiations problems and District tactics of "bad faith."
- B. The Insurance & Benefit Committees efforts towards guiding the district to use the irrevocable trust and its \$130,000,000.00+ reserves to fund retiree benefits.
- VII. Negotiations Report: Mohammad Abdel Haq & Robin Devitt provided information on their efforts on:
 - A. Lab/lecture parity, for which, in the recent UF survey, faculty showed overwhelming support, and the district has been stalling negotiations (see attached).
 - B. Achieving 75th percentile, for which the district has been stalling negotiations, even with MOU negotiations coming up fast.
 - C. Return to campus, which should be wrapped up quickly depending on the district's diligence.
 - ❖ (as an FYI, not counting the number of meetings amongst themselves, as of this date, the negotiating team has met with the district 12+ times to work out a resolution, and has recently sent the district a "demand to bargain" notice.
